## 1 License for the reproduced 1913 atlas and it's single elements

### 1.1 General information

These two scanned maps are an excerpt of an atlas of 1913. They are most probably free of any copyright and thus free for commercial and non commercial usage. The source is an original exemplar of 1913. I do not claim any copyright on these reproductions.

I intend to scan the whole atlas volume-I until 2011 and will publicize a detailed root document describing each map, translations included.

Both pictures were scanned with 8 bit color depth at 300 dpi, uncompressed TIFF-format. I did not add a color profile, not yet. When the atlas will be completely archived in 2011, a higher color depth is intended for some single maps.

"K.B." means "Königlich Bayerisch", Royal Bavarian, referring to the state's name, Bayern (Bavaria). *Atlas für höhere Lehranstalten* may be translated as *Atlas for establishments of higher education* or as *Atlas for institutions of higher education*. "Band I" is volume I, there is also a volume II which I do not own, not yet. For looking up German words you can use dictionaries such as [www.leo.org](http://www.leo.org) and [www.linguee.com](http://www.linguee.com).

The source of these atlas scans is an original of 1913.

## 1.4 License for the atlas resp. the single reproduction elements

### 1.4.1 Copyright

Most probably, there is no more copyright on the atlas resp. on these maps. They were published in 1913 and are 97 years old, in 2010. The publishing house no longer exists (according to piecewise linear time perception); you still can find books of it at antiquarian booksellers, including “Band II” (Volume II) of this atlas serial.

As I know, the copyright on material published in Germany before 1915 is valid for 50 years after the year of death of its copyright-holder. For material published since 1915, the copyright is extended to 70 years after the death of its copyright owner, the year of death not included. 2010 minus 50 equals 1960. Most probably, the copyright owner died before 1960.

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- Scaling of the image size, you also may downsize the image and it does not matter, if you no longer can read the text, as long as you do not delete text information by intention

- You may choose extracts/apertures of the maps, and you may combine them with your explanatory notes, e.g. arrows and text, visual emphasizezations and overlays
- Color and contrast adjustments: You may adjust all parameters, but within color images, you may not change the principal colors, e.g.: a green tone in the original may not be turned into a red tone, though you certainly may colorize areas and borders for explanatory highlightings
- Black and white conversion resp. monochromatic color conversion: Choose an appropriate conversion algorithm or individual method for your needs, I do not give any recommendation in this context as there is no general guideline for these conversions
- Removal of dust and discolorations, sharpening and softening, changing Buntgrad and Unbuntgrad (aspects of saturation), changing the file format etc.
